

The Great Commission:

[Matthew 28:18-20 ESV]

18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

[Mark 16:15-16 ESV]

15 And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation.

16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

How much Jesus loved us, to die on the cross for us:

[John 15:12-13 ESV]

12 "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.

13 Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.

How can you feel the love that Jesus has for us and not WANT to share it with the whole world, what happens is we start to feel overwhelmed and lose sight of Jesus, while we cannot share that love with the whole world at once, by

ourselves, we can share it with each little piece of the world we come into contact with each day.

Share the gospel, share the truth

[John 1:17 ESV]

17 For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

The truth of God through Jesus Christ, if doesn't matter what good you do for others, if they don't know that it comes from Christ through you.

Tell the story of the Lord with your works but also your voice

[James 2:17 ESV]

17 So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

[2 Corinthians 4:5 ESV]

5 For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake.

If you saw a starving person, and you were so loaded with food, that you could hardly carry it all, wouldn't you share some of that food with them, Jesus can fill you with so much of his love that all you can do is share it, but you have to take that step

[Romans 10:13-15 ESV]

13 For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

14 How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching?

15 And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!"

May the spirit of the Lord Jesus Christ abide in you in such abundances, that you are compelled every day to:
